

## Malippuram Fishing Village

(Elamkunnapuzha - G P Vypin Block)

### ***A Brief Profile of the Malippuram Fishing Villages***

Malippuram fisheries village is located in ward 22 of Elamkunnapuzha Gram Panchayat. The village has a total of 265 houses and 285 households are living there. Among them, 20 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 9.44 percent houses are pucca, 69.43 percent are semi-pucca and 21.13 percent houses are kachha houses. About 94.34 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 83.77 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (99.25 %) are electrified. It is noted that 116 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 19 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 8 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one CHC and two sub- centre. The village has two LP schools and UP Schools. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and two of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 4 roads of length 6.10 Km and one culvert. The village has 10 street lights and only five of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 10 country fishing boats and 2 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 68 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one market. The village has a protected coastal length of 3.65 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 20 and 21 while the financial requirements are given in Table 22.
